**Orlando, FL** – (August 13, 2018) - Entries are officially being accepted for the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Florida Film Festival sponsored by Full Sail University, April 12-21, 2019. Qualified filmmakers can submit their entries through Florida Film Festival's online entry form on [FloridaFilmFestival.com](http://FloridaFilmFestival.com) or through [Withoutabox.com/FFF](http://Withoutabox.com/FFF).

Competition categories include short films (both narrative and animation), documentary films (both short and feature length), narrative features, and international films (both short and feature length). Awards are determined by a jury of film professionals and by audience ballot.

The Florida Film Festival is one of only a handful of film festivals in the world to be accredited as a qualifying festival for the Oscars® in **all three** short film categories: Live Action, Animation, and Documentary. The winner of the Grand Jury Award in each of these categories will automatically qualify to enter the following year's Academy Awards®.
