THE 2021 FLORIDA FILM FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES CALL FOR ENTRIES

Orlando, FL – (September 1, 2020) – Entries are officially being accepted for the 30th Annual Florida Film Festival, taking place April 9-18, 2021, and sponsored by Full Sail University. Qualified filmmakers can submit their entries on FloridaFilmFestival.com through [Film Freeway](#).

Competition categories include short films (both narrative and animation), documentary films (both short and feature length), narrative features, and international films (both short and feature length). Awards are determined by a jury of film professionals and by audience ballot.

Deadlines to submit are:

October 16, 2020 – Early Entry Deadline November 13, 2020 – Regular Entry Deadline November 27, 2020 – Late Entry Deadline December 11, 2020 – Extended Late Entry Deadline

The Florida Film Festival is one of only a handful of film festivals in the world, and the only one in the state, to be accredited as a qualifying festival for the Oscars® in **all three** short film categories: Live Action, Animation, and Documentary. The winner of the Grand Jury Award in each of these categories will automatically qualify to enter the following year's Academy Awards®.
