# THE 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL FLORIDA FILM FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES GRAND JURY & AUDIENCE AWARD WINNERS

**Orlando, FL** – (April 27, 2021) The Florida Film Festival has announced the Grand Jury and Audience Awards of the 2021 Florida Film Festival. The 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Florida Film Festival took place April 9-22, 2021, in Maitland and Winter Park, Florida, with Primary Sponsor Full Sail University and Primary Public Partners Orange County Government and the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs.

During the festival, staff was pleased to host an in-person, 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration, recognizing Florida Film Festival Founders Philip and Sigrid Tiedtke for their vision and 30 years of selfless dedication to independent film in Central Florida. Additionally, Matthew Curtis was recognized for his contributions to FFF and Enzian Theater, receiving an award in appreciation of 25 years of excellence as Programming Director.
